A Note From SBETC.....


The town of Sheffield has decided they will no longer be using Southern Berkshire Elderly Transportation (SBETC) for transportation for their seniors and disabled of any age. SBETC has been servicing Sheffield since the organization was formed 30 years ago. We have enjoyed transporting the seniors and disabled from Sheffield. They will be missed! SBETC

The Registry of Motor Vehicles advised motorists of a new law taking effect on April 7 requiring the use of headlights and taillights on motor vehicles during inclement weather and when windshield wipers are in use. The law is intended to increase safety and visibility of vehicles on the Commonwealth's roadway.

The changes to Mass General Law Chapter 85, Section 15, signed into law in January, require that front and rear motor vehicle lights be activated in all of the following conditions:

- *When windshield wipers are on
- *When low light or weather conditions prevent other vehicles or persons from being seen at 500 feet
- *From ½ hour after sunset to ½ hour before sunrise

The penalty for a violation of c.85, Section 15 is contained in MGL c.85, Section 17. It is \$5.

Pacific Coast Trail facts:

The Pacific Crest Trail is 2,663 mi (4,286 km) long and ranges in elevation from just above sea level at the Oregon–Washington border to 13,153 feet (4,009 m) at Forester Pass in the Sierra Nevada. The route passes through 25 national forests and 7 national parks. Its midpoint is near Chester California (near Mt Lassen), where the Sierra and Cascade mountain ranges meet.
