Tate met with Sue recently who said there is enough documentation to do this but we need W-9s that are missing. Natasha was putting items in the Town Hall mail box by tomorrow, Tate will add his signature and will get us started on that process.

Patrick said he would be willing to assist if there are some things Tate needs help with for the moment but cannot take on the Treasurer position.

Lost quorum at 6:45 as Tate and Nan had to leave. Meeting continued to Citizen's Speak.

V. Citizen Speak

Bob Holcomb looking for ideas on Housatonic. School has been vacant, etc. GBCC rewards grants to groups and individuals and was wondering if we have had any applicants regarding that topic. Ellen says we have not so far as things have been pushed back for COVID, cycle just started for this coming year.
