- 5:38pm: Call to Order
 - Present: Michael Andelman, Catherine Hancock, Ellen Shanahan
- Michael motioned for the minutes from 7/18 GBCC meeting to be approved. Since only 3 members were present, we were unable to vote. Minute approval will have to be postponed until next meeting.
- Michael discussed possibility of disbanding due to shortage of members. Ellen determined that she can renew her term, meaning the Cultural Council will have the minimum number of members necessary to be able to vote. Disbanding is not necessary.
- Discussion of recruiting new members:
 - Michael cited that the Cultural Council has had no interest from Great Barrington residents after advertising, appearing at the town meeting, and the cultural district meeting.

 - Proposed projects should benefit Great Barrington.
 - Council favors projects that are free to attend.
 - All Massachusetts residents can apply.

- Discussion of GBCC events
 - Catherine voiced concern about timing of a September event- Michael and Ellen agreed.
 - Next year we will plan a September event to promote the grant deadline and our presence in the community.
 - We will explore the possibility of a winter event to recruit new members.
 - In order to successfully organize GBCC events, it will be necessary to have the whole council involved in planning, and ideally we would need more members.
