**IV. PERMIT FOR REVIEW: 292 MAIN STREET**

Ellen House was present on behalf of Iredale's to discuss a sign application for 292 Main Street. The wall mounted sign would have raised letters and will be 12 square feet. There is not lighting proposed.

The Committee discussed window signs for 292 Main Street. Ms. House said the front windows would have static signs on the inside of the windows.

Mr. May said the static signs would not cover more than 50% of the windows. The top portion of the window would remain clear.

Mr. Hankin asked if there would be text on the window.

Ms. House said there would be text on a clear background.

Mr. Hankin asked what would be seen through the clear areas.

Ms. House said white drapes.

The Committee said the applicant does not need to return to the Committee for changes to the window signs as long as they stay within the parameters of the sign bylaw.

Town Planner Chris Rembold was present to show the Committee some street light designs for their review and comment. Railroad Street is going to have work done to replace lighting and repair sidewalks as well as other improvements. He provided pictures of different street light styles.
