- **B.** GREAT BARRINGTON BOARD OF HEALTH PUBLIC ADVISORY: To review and amend the Public Health Advisory implemented on September 15, 2021 pertaining to COVID-19 and community safety and precautions.

Health Agent Rebecca Jurczyk reviewed the current advisory with proposed updates and edits. This discussion included travel events, outdoor and indoor gatherings, testing, ventilation, personal hygiene and healthcare, measures of wellbeing, and masking among the main topics.

Also discussed were the policies in place in surrounding towns. In order to have a clear Mandate the Board of Health would have to develop a regulation, which is best done in a public hearing. Options we have are either A Public Health Advisory or a Directive or a Mandate. A Directive is more of a stronger language than Advisory. Board member Ruby Chang and Health Agent Rebecca Jurczyk talked in detail about the different forms of testing, and what to expect with a positive test.

Restaurant guidance and signage was also discussed.

Comments and suggestions from audience were heard and taken into consideration.

The amended advisory is effective as of December 14th, 2021.
