The new Brownstone material is being sourced and smaller stone may need to be used. Shop Drawings and samples will be the next step in the construction contract award process. Any update for these items would be reviewed at the Regular HDC Meeting in April.

Motion by Abby Schroeder to close the public hearing with a second by Marilyn Bisiewicz. Amended by James Mercer to continue the hearing until the April Regular Meeting. Motion passed by a roll call vote with Howe, Mercer, Schroeder, Clark and Bisiewicz all voting in favor.
