A. Updates from Sean VanDeusen, DPW Superintendent Memorial Field, Budget and Tighe and Bond

Sean noted the link of the draft assessment management was sent to all the members. Included is a map of Dewey Park. Tighe and Bond will be doing a town wide survey on the upgrade of Dewey Park and Grove Street. Foresight is doing bid documents for the bathrooms at Olympian Meadows. It was determined that possibly the Police and Fire will sign off on the Parks Usage Request form prior to coming to the Parks Commissioners and Board of Health. The form is being updated. The capital spread sheet will be updated. CPA money was approved for ADA/sidewalk compliance and will go before the town meeting.

6 **OLD BUSINESS:**

- A. <u>Berkshire South</u> Andrew noted they are working on staffing. The Greenagers are putting in garden beds in Housatonic. The RFP will be submitted next week.
- B. <u>Railroad Street Youth Project</u> Sam said they are putting out fliers for the skate park and starting the interview process. He has been in contact with Damien from the library skate shop in Great Barrington and he wants to do free lessons like he did a couple of years ago. 8. COMMISSIONER'S SPEAK:

There was discussion on the floor covering at the Community Center. Bill said it would be a good investment to purchase a floor covering. Stephen Bannon said the furniture that was in the Select Board's meeting room is now in the conference room at the community center. The conference room was painted and we have to revamp the insulation for the ceiling. Bill will send the vinyl floor covering information they use at Simon's Rock to Sean. There is a water filling station there now.

Paul said we can buy a floor covering and have it cut to the dimensions of the floor. The storage container for football at Olympian meadows needs to be moved. Sean said he will follow-up on this.

Ilana said the Housatonic Community Center needs to be used more. We need to invest money in it. There is currently a floor covering there that is not in use. Sean and Karen will go look at what is there for floor covering. Karen noted that there isn't a budget to maintain the center.

Tom Norton –if the covering that is there can't be used – we should do something with it. There was a question on the bike trail and if it is still being scheduled to be surfaced? Sean said the existing contracts have gone up so he isn't sure when it will happen. The home gas property and the solar field – is there an exit? Sean said it is a dead end.
