A skating rink for ice skating at Grove Street Park.

The early childhood structure needs improvement also at Grove Street.

The bridge leading to the park needs to be fixed. Karen suggested the Green agers or Berkshire School could possibly clean the stuff out from the stream.

Rope structure for climbing/better swings

A new basketball hoop would be nice. Joe Aberdale said he would look into the prices of hoops. The surface needs to be redone.

Barbeque Grills would be nice.

The basketball court needs to be enclosed.

Handicapped accessibility is needed It was noted that some of the structures at Grove Street Park need to be removed. Lake Mansfield is a good model Picnic tables are being built
