Call to Order: The Chair will conduct a roll call to identify attendees. All votes taken during the meeting will be roll call votes. Participants please identify themselves before speaking. This meeting is being recorded.

- 1. Approval of Minutes of the April 24, 2024 meeting.
- 2. Request for Determination of Applicability from White Engineering on behalf of Regio Almori, property at 185 State Road, Map 12 Lot 85. The proposed work consists of spreading fill material and top soil on the vacant lot east of the Plaza Package Store to level the property and stabilize with native seed mix. Erosion controls are to be installed, inspected and approved by the Commission or its Agent prior to starting further grading and will remain in place until vegetation has been uniformly established across the entire lot. All work will be within the Buffer Zone of extensive wetlands down-hill and north of the site.
- 3. Request for Certificate of Compliance (DEP File 167-305) from Ethan Klepetar on behalf of HAMFAS, LLC. The original Order of Conditions was dated May 23, 2007. The work was never started and the Order expired in May of 2010. The Commission is requested to certify that the Order is no longer valid and that any future work subject to regulation under the Wetlands Protection Act may not commence without filing a new Notice of Intent and receiving a new Order of Conditions.
