




Driveway Permit 267 Long Pond Road, Great Barrington

267 Long Pond Road currently has 2 existing driveways. The northerly one is requested to remain and is currently in excess of 30+ feet wide. The southerly driveway is identified as to be abandoned. The location of the new driveway has good visibility in both directions of Long Pond Road.

The DPW has no objection to the proposed driveway location. DPW would recommend as part of the permit if granted:

- That the southernmost driveway to be abandoned be removed from the Town right-of-way no more than 30 days after the new driveway has been installed.
- That the Town's driveway design requirements in the bylaws be followed.

The driveway bylaw allows 2 driveways per lot at a minimum of 8' wide to a maximum of 16' wide. The proposed driveway is proposed at 20' wide, exceeding the bylaw by 4'. It is the Selectboards' prerogative if they would like to grant a driveway width in excess of the maximum 16' specified in the bylaw.



At the March 6, 2023 meeting of the Historical Commission, Gary Leveille presented a statement concerning the recent disposal of historical artifacts by the Library, which was apparently done with Selectboard approval but without consultation with the Historical Commission. Mr. Leveille's statement is attached.

The Historical Commission voted unanimously that you be requested to adopt a policy requiring Historical Commission approval for the disposal of any Town historical assets. During the meeting, concern was expressed about paintings and other artwork that adorn Mason Library. Much of the artwork was loaned to the Library by the Historical Commission and the Great Barrington Historical Society. Such a policy as we recommend would ensure that the Town's historical artifacts such as these have a proper historical review prior to their disposal.

Background Regarding Mason Library Artifacts Collection

Presented by Gary Leveille to the Great Barrington Historical Commission, March 6, 2023

I want to discuss recent newspaper articles pertaining to the Mason Library collection of indigenous stone artifacts. They include projectile points, stone tools, pottery shards and possible spiritual effigies.

Here is some background. When Charles Taylor wrote his *History of Great Barrington* in the 1880s, it was first serialized in the *Berkshire Courier* newspaper. As word got out about his research, local farmers and property owners brought him Native American stone artifacts they had found on their property over the years. He amassed a collection, and at some point it ended up at the library. The collection was on display for decades in lower level of the Mason Library. In preparation of the major library expansion that took place a number of years ago, the collection was put in storage. I think it is fair to describe the collection as being owned by the town.

Several years ago, I was involved in a collaborative effort between the G.B. Historical Society, the town's Historical Commission, and the Director of the G.B. Libraries to launch a major exhibit of the artifacts described above at the G.B. Historical Society Museum and Research Center on South Main St. aka the Wheeler Farmstead. The plan was to set up a display, catalog it, and create a photo book to sell as a fund-raiser for the library. The library Director at the time (Amanda DeGiorgis) got approval for this exhibit from the Library Trustees.

Then COVID hit. Everything was put on hold. Not long ago, Amanda resigned.

Much to my surprise, recently, newspaper articles stated that the new Library Director and Library Trustees plan to turn over the collection to the Stockbridge-Munsee Band of Mohican Indians. According to one newspaper article, this was approved by the Great Barrington Selectboard. New Library Director Samara Klein noted that this was "in order to comply with the 1990 Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act." (NAGPRA). In my opinion, it is arguable that some of the artifacts may not be applicable to NAGPRA.

Several years ago, several residents of Stockbridge discovered material (including early town documents) they felt should be turned over to the Stockbridge-Munsee Community. They followed a procedure that included (1) Approval of the Selectboard (2) Special town meeting (3) Approval of the state legislature. I do not know where this policy originated.

I once read a town document that described the duties of the Great Barrington Historical Commission. Among the responsibilities is to serve as advisors to the Selectboard. Although this task is not specifically spelled out in the MGL Chapter 40 laws, I know I read it somewhere – perhaps the Master Plan or another town document.

I do not necessarily disagree with the Library Trustees and Selectboard decision. However, I strongly believe that the Historical Commission should have been consulted in this matter and been part of the discussion with the Stockbridge-Munsee Community. In my opinion, part of the reason the Historical Commission was created was to serve such a purpose. I think that the Selectboard, town boards, commissions and town employees need to be reminded that they should consult with us when matters of historical importance arise.
