The Selectboard is in receipt of your Open Meeting Law (OML) complaint. Your complaint alleges the following:

1. "The last meeting minutes of the board posted is from 5/22/23. Since that date there have been meetings without minutes posted on 6/12, 6/13, 6/26, 7/10, and 8/2."

The action requested is as follows:

1. "Post the minutes on the town website expeditiously to allow public access to the information discussed."

As a result of the above complaint, the Selectboard/Town Manager's staff posted any missing approved minutes to the website in the usual location.

In addition, it's important to note that all of our Selectboard meetings are recorded and posted publicly within 24-48 hours on our website.

The Selectboard continues to obey and respect the Open Meeting Law by operating in a transparent manner at all times. We hope this response clears up any concerns you may have and we thank you for bringing this matter to our attention.
