

## Parking

From November 15<sup>th</sup> through March 30<sup>th</sup>, overnight on-street parking is prohibited between the hours of 1:00 am and 6:00 am. Violators will be ticketed. Vehicles that block DPW snow plows will be towed at the owner's expense. Overnight parking is permitted in many parking lots in the downtown area including: the Town Hall lot, top of Railroad Street lot, Castle Street lot, and the Mason Library parking lot.

The Town's overnight on-street winter parking ban is in effect immediately.

On November 1<sup>st</sup>, and at times throughout the two-weeks prior to the start of the overnight parking ban, the Great Barrington Police Department will issue warning notifications to inform all of the upcoming start of the prohibition.

Signs will be installed on parking lots where overnight parking is allowed.

The Town Manager will determine the feasibility of issuing residents parking stickers and establish a rule that parking in parking lots will be restricted to a maximum of 24 hours.
