Two follow up activities: 1: a celebration of folks involved in year 1 with review and honoring of folks work. 2: Presentation to select board on idea to create signage at parks in spanish; Jovanina and Chris Remhbold working on this.

Jovanina: We need to put on somebody's radar: We've reconvened as a committee, this is what we've agreed to, how can we move forward?
