III. Arbor Day 2023

- Can we highlight some new plantings? Town Hall, Mason Library, Ramsdell Library (Housatonic) would be good locations
- River Walk upstream tree ID challenge likely to happen again too
- Suggestion box for citizens to suggest tree maintenance/plantings
- AI: Gary to request from town clerk that the Selectboard vote to officially recognize the observation Arbor Day
- AI: Mary to talk to Julia Ericsson, library committee member to see if we can determine a planting site
- Al: Michael to reach out to Tom Ingersall and Greg Ward about participating
- Al: Julie to reach out to Holly and Director of Mason Library to see if she can help facilitate event scheduling events at Mason Library
- AI: Gary to reach out to GB Land Conservatory (Christine Ward) may also be a good partner

• Estimate \$1,000/tree

- \$40K will be requested for 2024 (\$20K DPW / \$20K town budget)
- Need to identify locations (street and parks) that we want to recommend plantings
- Action item: consider locations for 2024 for next meeting
